In April we will begin our Children & Youth school supply collection. We hope the Post members will continue to be as generous as they have in the past.

The Veterans Pantry continues to need replenishing. Last fall we were preparing approximately 20 veteran food boxes per month; in February 2022 we prepared 70 food boxes that were picked up and delivered by the VA Case Managers. Due to HIPPA laws, we do not know the identity of the veterans we are helping but, rest assured, all the veterans we work with are vetted by the VA, and associated with James A. Haley Veterans Hospital, and are assigned to and working with a case manager. In addition to food, we provide starter baskets, including cleaning supplies, dishes, linens, etc., for homeless veterans transitioning into housing. We also accept furniture, in very good condition, realizing that these veterans have nothing at the time they are initially housed. We appreciate all the assistance our Auxiliary and Legion family members give us.
