As I said at the beginning, I am just back from Department of Florida Convention. We had a great, very well attended Riders' general session. I would like to share some information from the meeting: We now have 43 chapters in the state of Florida with 3,356 riders. We rode 1,429,000 miles. The Riders raised \$469,945 for various charitable activities. We volunteered 141,000 hours in support of 980 different programs. Our first In-state Legacy Run visited 31 posts, consisted of an 1,815 run from Pensacola, down the West Coast, to Key West, back up the east Coast to Jacksonville, and home to the panhandle. The Riders raised \$12,000 for the Legacy Scholarship Fund.

Yesterday at the General Session checks totaling \$12,400 dollars for the Legacy Scholarship were presented to be given at National Convention in August. I am proud to report our Chapter donation of \$1,000. All of this is a prime example of why our new motto in Florida is "Do good, ride hard, have fun." Thanks once again for all of your support and remember, "Watch out for Motorcycles".
